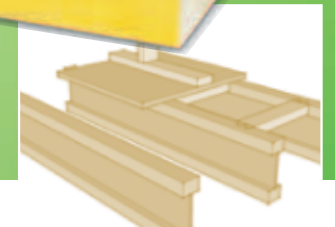

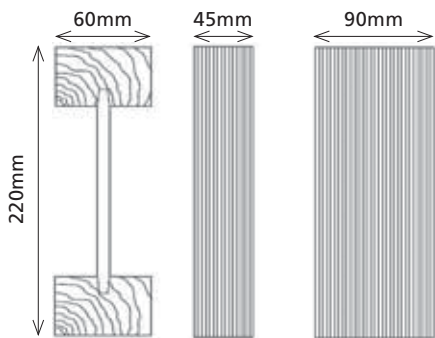

Service Class 1

Imposed load not exceeding 1.5 kN/m². Dead load not exceeding 0.75 kN/m² (0.5 kN/m² Dead + 0.25 kN/m² non-load bearing partitions)

The following notes should be considered when selecting Header C materials in STEP 2:

a. When Trimmer D or Header C support staircase loads from above **and** below, Header C material should be a minimum 45 mm STEICOultralam R (ULR).

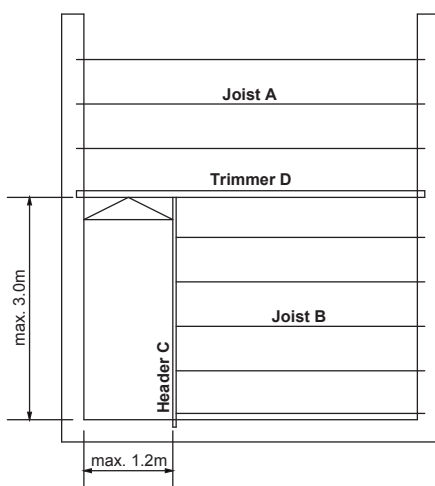
b. Where Header C is 2.0 m or longer, and supports the head of the staircase, Header C material should be a minimum 45 mm STEICOultralam R (ULR).

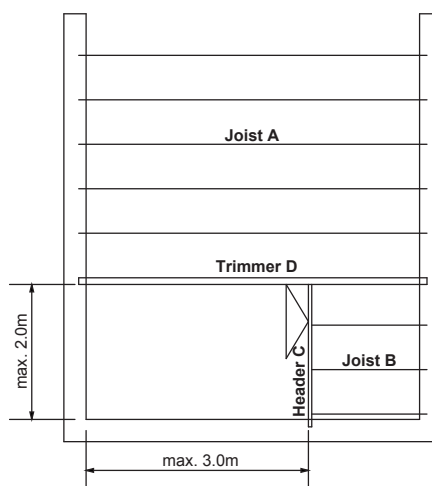

WORKED EXAMPLE

Staircase Perpendicular to Joists



Staircase Parallel to Joists



Joist span = 4.5 m

Staircase perpendicular = 2.8 m x 1.1 m

STEP 1

Joist A Span = 4.5 m

Centers = 400 mm

Joist B Span = 3.4 m (4.5 m – 1.1 m)

Centers = 600 mm

STEP 2

Span Joist B = 3.4 m (use 3.5 m)

Length of Header C = 2.8 m

(use 3.0 m)

Header C = 45 mm STEICOultralam R

STEP 3

Header C material = 45 mm

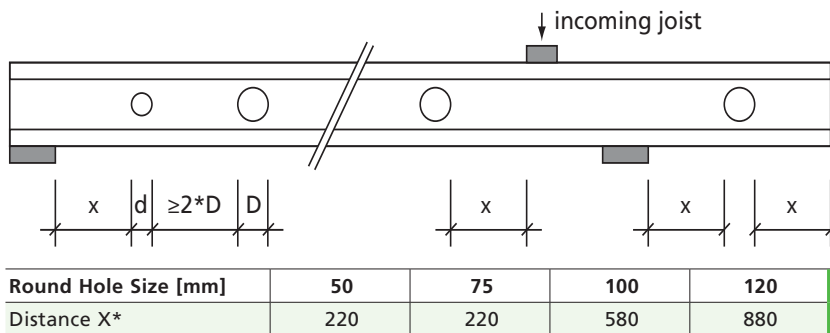

Span of Trimmer D = 4.5 m

Trimmer D = 2 x 90 mm

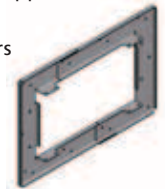
HOLES CAN BE CUT THROUGH THE STEICOtradejoist IN LINE WITH THE DRAWING AND TABLE BELOW



*Minimum distance in mm from inside face of any support to nearest edge of hole.

20 mm holes can be drilled anywhere in the web. Distance between hole edges min 40 mm.

For larger holes close to supports use Simpson IHS. Fixed in line with manufacturers recommendations.



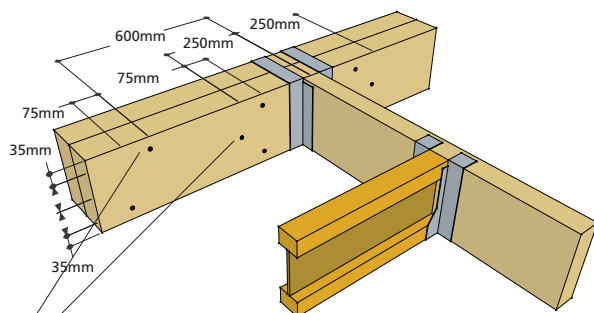

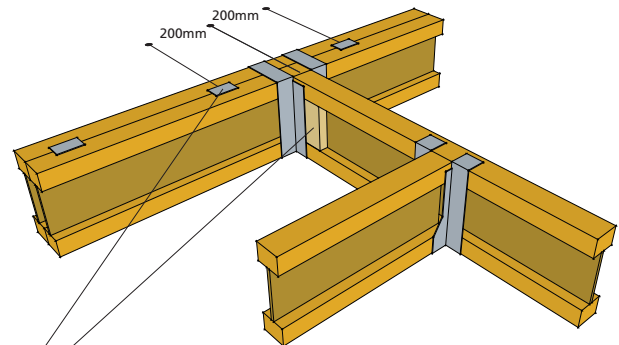


STEICOultralam CONNECTION



Fix with 2 rows of Simpson SDW22634 screws at max 600mm centers, with an additional 3 screws both sides of incoming member

STEICOtradejoist CONNECTION



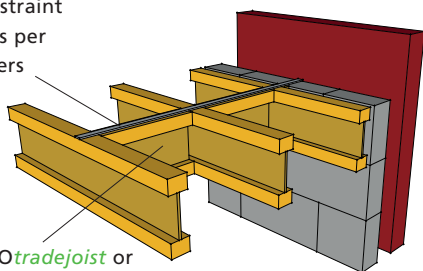
Use 25 mm x 100 mm x 125 mm ply/OSB web stiffener with STEICOtradejoist header.

Number of multi ply connections at incoming member as table below.

Incoming Member	Simpson MJC	Cullen I-Clip
TJ60/220	1 pair either side	1-either side
STEICOultralam	2 pairs either side	2-either side

Masonry wall restraint

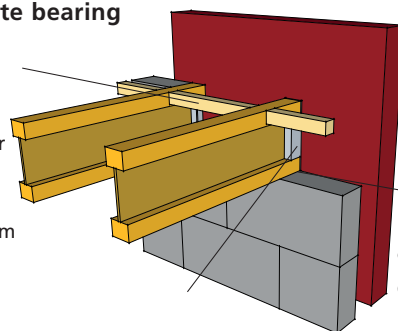
SimpsonTM HES or CullenTM PFS restraint strap required as per Building Designers specification



Full depth STEICOtradejoist or min 38*120 solid timber noggin

Intermediate bearing

Min. 38*38 perimeter noggin fixed with Z-Clip or skew nailed. Positioned 25-75mm from face of wall.

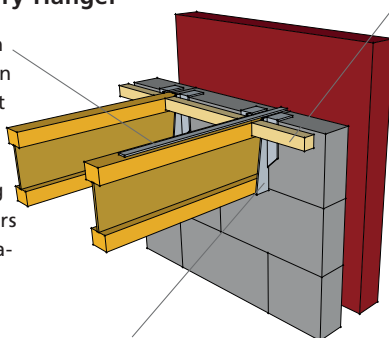


Min. 90mm end bearing.

Simpson SES143/63 or Cullen GR225-2 End Seal to ensure compliance with air leakage requirements

Masonry Hanger

Simpson or Cullen restraint strap as per Building Designers specification

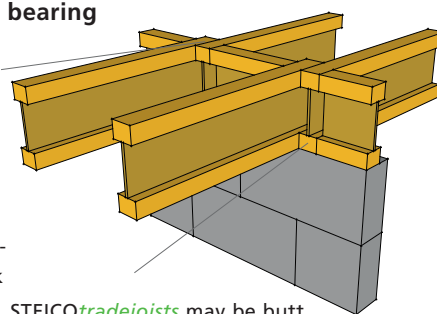


Min. 38*38 perimeter noggin fixed with Z-Clip or skew nailed. Positioned 25-75mm from face of wall.

Simpson or Cullen Masonry hangers

Intermediate bearing

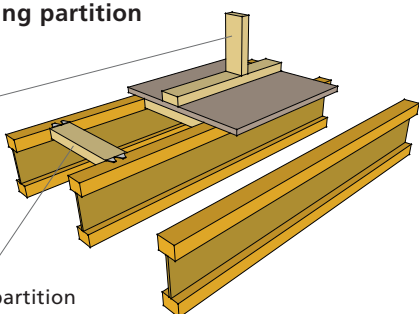
Stagger end of joists and ensure either STEICOtradejoist blocking is fitted or continuous blockwork



STEICOtradejoists may be butt jointed where there is a minimum of 45mm bearing available.

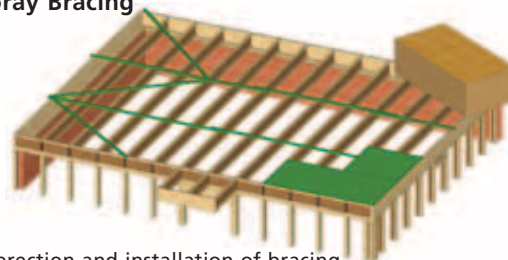
Non load bearing partition

Maximum weight of non load bearing partitions 0.8 kN/m.



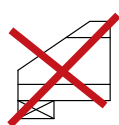
Minimum 38*75 partition noggin fixed to STEICOtradejoist at 600mm centers using Z-Clip

Temporay Bracing

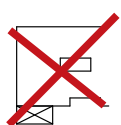

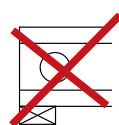
Do not angle cut
